## *Submission guidelines:*

- Open to all students who were enrolled in an ARTS class in Fall 2016 and/or Spring 2017.
- Students may submit up to 3 works. Any artwork made after the 2016 Juried Exhibition may be entered.
- There are no theme, size, or media restrictions. With one exception for installation work, only actual artwork is accepted for jurying (no pictures, diagrams, or other substitutions.) Only **original** work will be accepted.
- For installations, submit suitable documentation for the faculty jurying process (i.e. up to three photographs of installed work/ details/ samples. Jurying will occur only in Biggin Gallery, off-site locations are not eligible.
- All artwork must be ready for exhibition; 2D work should be matted, framed (with hanging wire if necessary), or otherwise prepared for installation.

- Artwork not selected for exhibition must be picked up between 7 pm Friday, 3/24 and Monday, 3/27.
- Artwork must remain on exhibition for the full duration of the show. If batteries, bulbs, etc. are required, they must be supplied in sufficient quantity.
- Exhibition closes on Friday, 4/7, and all work must be picked up between 7:45 - 4:45 on Monday 4/10.
