



## Medication Red Flag Criteria



For each child on your caseload, ask yourself the questions below. Are they:

- Prescribed four or more psychotropic medications?
- Prescribed two or more medications of the same type (e.g., stimulants, antipsychotics)?
- Under age 5 and prescribed psychiatric medications?
- Prescribed high dosages?
- Experiencing bothersome side effects (e.g., not eating, eating too much, having difficulties sleeping or waking up)?

If *at least one* of these boxes is checked, reach out to APMRT and request a Medication Review.

- Medication Reviews are FREE!
- Medication Reviews can be completed for a child in ANY county.
- Medication Review does not include behavioral services.

Unsure if your clients meet the criteria above? Send a referral anyway!
